

DRYSTONE WALL

This wall was constructed in accordance with traditional techniques and in keeping with the aesthetics of the built heritage. The sandstone and limestone used were reused from materials associated with the manor house construction site.

This wall is a site of interest within the Cross-Channel Geopark. The use of materials sourced from the local geology, combined with traditional craftsmanship, bears witness to the bond between people and the land.

Drystone walls form part of the cultural and landscape heritage of the *Caps et Marais d'Opale*. The *Parc naturel régional* supports the passing on of traditional techniques.
